**SIGNAL SERVICE REPORT**

The Signal Service Report was discussed. President Shore said he is not happy with the service we have been getting because some of the maintenance items are not being done. The report that Signal Service sends out yearly seems to be the same list of issues from the previous years that were done.

**TRAINING FOR DIRT AND GRAVEL AND LOW VOLUME ROADS PROGRAM**

The Secretary will attend a two-day training for the dirt and gravel and low volume roads program. Someone from the Borough is required to attend to be eligible to apply for program funds.

**204 CHURCH STREET – CUTONE MUSHROOM**

Trucks that are going in and out of Cutone Mushrooms are running over the Borough's curb stop to the fire hydrant and damaging it. Also, there is a lot of mud on the roadway from the trucks. Kim Venzie will speak with Anthony Campbell on these issues.

**MOWER PROPOSAL**

The mower proposal will be presented to Council for approval.

**RESOLUTION – SUPPORT MUNICIPAL POLICE TO USE RADAR GUNS**

The Resolution will be presented to Council for adoption.

**OLD DUMP TRUCK AND SALT SPREADER**

The Secretary will call DEP and find out the particulars on what the Borough needs to do to sell the truck and salt spreader since they were purchased in part with DEP grant money.

**DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS**

The delinquent accounts were reviewed. Shut off notices were sent out last week.

**STREET SWEEPING PROPOSAL**

The cost for street sweeping with an operator is \$528.00 for 4 hours. After discussion, it was agreed to approve one 8-hour day. When a date is scheduled, residents will be notified to park off the street.

Ms. Venzie said she is working on the following items: Intermunicipal Agreement Ordinance, water rate increase / penalties for repeat offenders, tax credit for fire company volunteers, and the Airport Zoning Ordinance.
