### 91 PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE WATERLINE

The waterline is exposed and sometimes freezes in the winter. The Secretary spoke with Andy and he said we would have to bore under Pennsylvania Avenue to connect directly to the water main. Another solution is to wrap the water line in rubber insulation. President Shore said he wants to take a look to see if there is another way to connect the waterline.
