NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Avondale, Chester County, Pennsylvania, will conduct a public hearing, as part of its regularly scheduled meeting, on Tuesday, December 21, 2021 in the Avondale Borough Hall, 110 Pomeroy Avenue, Pennsylvania at 6:00 p.m., prevailing time to consider, and immediately thereafter decide whether to enact an ordinance levying real estate taxes, totaling 5.0 mills, collected for the 2022 fiscal year, consisting of a general purpose real estate tax, a fire services tax, an emergency medical services tax and a tax for lighting, on the assessed value of all taxable real estate in the Borough. A complete copy of the proposed Ordinance may be examined and copies obtained (for the cost of reproducing same) at the Borough's administrative offices located at 110 Pomeroy Avenue, Pennsylvania 19311 on Mondays through Fridays between 8:00 am and 4:00 pm. **ORDINANCE NO. 2021 -271
BOROUGH OF AVONDALE
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVONDALE, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, LEVYING A GENERAL PURPOSE REAL ESTATE TAX, A FIRE SERVICES TAX, AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TAX AND A TAX FOR LIGHTING AND ILLUMINATING THE STREETS, HIGHWAYS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES FOR THE 2022 FISCAL YEAR

The Council of the Borough of Avondale, Chester County, Pennsylvania, hereby ORDAINS that real estate taxes, totaling 5 mills (which translates to a rate of fifty (50) cents on each one hundred (\$100) dollars of assessed valuation of taxable property) shall be levied and collected for the 2022 fiscal year, for the following purposes, at the following millage, on the assessed value of all taxable real estate in the Borough:

1. Three and fifty-five one-hundredths (3.55) mills for general purposes;
2. Fifty one-hundredths (0.50) of a mill dedicated to Fire Services;
3. Fifty one-hundredths (0.50) of a mill dedicated to Emergency Medical Services;
and
4. Forty-five one-hundredths (0.45) of a mill dedicated to street lighting.
