After the Pledge of Allegiance, the meeting was called to order by President Shore at 6:00 p.m.

There was a moment of silence for the passing of Junior Snyder.

PROPOSED WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ORDINANCE

President Shore opened the public hearing. There were no public comments. The public hearing was closed.

Dave Besselman made a motion to adopt Ordinance #237, 2nd by Jim Duffy, motion carried.

DANNY ROSAZZA

Mr. Rosazza said they just had the annual Ducky Race and the next year's race will be on April 20, 2013.

EEMA REPORT

Council reviewed the monthly report. Steve Cummings asked about the high sludge hauling. William Fansler said with the sludge production increases with warmer weather.

FENCE AT RESERVOIR

Steve Cummings made a motion to approve up to \$2,295.00 to install a fence to protect the valves at the reservoir, 2nd by Dave Besselman, motion carried.

SOUTH WELL PUMP REPLACEMENT

Dave Friedman said three bids were received for the replacement of the well pump #2, video inspection, and well yield test. We are not sure how deep the well is because old documents show different depths. There are three options for different size motors. President Shore asked if the wells were videoed since Council approved it last month. Mr. Friedman said no that it was included with this bid and you can't video unless you remove the well pump because it sits right on top. Electrically the well houses are in about as good shape as they are going to get. Jim Duffy made a motion to approve K.L. Madron for up to \$25,000.00 to replace the well pump, video, well yield test, and engineering fees, 2nd by Dave Besselman, motion carried. This will be paid out of the General Fund for emergency pump replacement. Mr. Friedman said this well will be able to be integrated with the well head protection project.

WATERLINE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT- PHASE 3 - CONSTRUCTION RELEASE #2

Dave Besselman made a motion to approve the construction release of \$171,546.30 to JOAO & Bradley Construction Company, Inc., 2nd by Abby Pyle, motion carried. Note: JOAO & Bradley will not be paid until the County releases the money to Avondale Borough.

Jim Duffy made a motion to approve the minutes from April 17, 2012, 2nd by Dave Besselman, motion carried.

WATER AND SEWER COMMITTEE

Dave Besselman gave the following report: The Committee met on May 8, 2012.

MAXIMUM FITNESS INVOICE

Ken Finley attended the meeting to discuss his invoice he received for engineering and attorney's fees. Mr. Finley was upset because he wasn't given advance notice that he was responsible for paying these fees. Herb MacCombie will supply a breakdown of the hours spent on this project. Mr. Finley was looking for a cost reduction but wasn't offered one and he may need to be put on a payment plan. The office will make it a practice to notify owners of upcoming invoices for projects.

313 CHURCH STREET

Marlene Tinnin owner of 313 Church Street received a high water and sewer bill for over \$1,446.60. The meter was checked and apparently the meter is working properly. The Committee agreed to swap out the meter because the water usage appeared to be excessive and the Committee made arrangements with the owner that she could pay the bill over three months and it was confirmed in writing. The old meter will be sent to Sensus to be tested. The cost of the meter testing will be waived since the Committee recommended the meter swap out.

NEW BILL FORMAT

Dave Besselman made a motion to change the bill format from the postcard to a $8 \frac{1}{2}$ x 11 format, 2^{nd} by Jim Duffy, motion carried.

RESERVOIR COVER INSPECTION
