

NOTICE IS GIVEN that on **September 20, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.**, prevailing time, Council for the Borough of Avondale, Chester County, Pennsylvania, will hold a public hearing as part of the regularly scheduled public meeting at Avondale Borough Hall, 110 Pomeroy Avenue, Avondale, Pennsylvania, to consider the adoption of, and if approved, Borough Council will adopt an Ordinance with the following title:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVONDALE, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE BOROUGH OF AVONDALE'S STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE, WHICH WAS ADOPTED ON JANUARY 28, 2014 AS ORDINANCE NO. 243, AND ADOPTING AMENDMENTS REQUIRED BY THE 2022 CHESTER COUNTY MODEL ACT 167 STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE.

The Ordinance proposes to amend the Borough's Stormwater Management Ordinance to be consistent with the Chester County 2022 Model Act 167 Stormwater Management Ordinance. In summary, the Ordinance provides for required updates to the Borough's stormwater management regulations in order to be consistent with the requirements of the County and Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection. The Ordinance provides for revised general provisions, updated definitions, updated stormwater management standards, site plan requirements, maintenance responsibilities, prohibitions, and enforcement provisions. The full text of the Ordinance is available on the Borough's website at avondaleboro.net.
