BILL ONLINE WITH INVOICE CLOUD!**



The Borough Council is pleased to announce the launch of its new online billing and payment service through **Invoice Cloud**, offering residents and property owners greater flexibility to view and pay your Water, Sewer and Trash bill online. Customers will have more choices to pay your bill, including by phone and by text, credit card, Venmo and Apple and Google pay.

The new, easy-to-use payment portal provides customers with quick access to your account to view bills, check your balance, make payments, and enroll in paperless billing. Features include an "at a glance" dashboard, securely storing payment information (if requested), and more automatic payment options including choosing a specific day for payments to process, email reminders, and linking multiple accounts. For customers that choose not to create an account, you can view your current bill and make a one-time payment without registering.

A 24/7 automated payment line is available for customers to make a payment or check a balance by calling 844-599-1239. We hope you take advantage of this new service! You can continue to pay your bill with a check or money order (made payable to Avondale Borough).
