

## **NOTICE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Avondale, Chester County, Pennsylvania, will conduct a public hearing, as part of its regularly scheduled meeting, on Tuesday, December 5, 2023 in the Avondale Borough Hall, 110 Pomeroy Avenue, Pennsylvania at 7:00 p.m., prevailing time to consider, and immediately thereafter decide whether to amend the Avondale Borough Code of Ordinances by enactment of an ordinance which is titled and summarized as follows:

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVONDALE, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF BOROUGH OF AVONDALE BY UPDATING AND EXPANDING CHAPTER 281 TO RENAME THE CHAPTER AND INCLUDE PROVISIONS TO CONTROL NOISE WITHIN THE BOROUGH, PROHIBIT LOUD AND UNREASONABLE NOISES, PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS TO PROTECT THE PEACE AND GOOD ORDER OF THE BOROUGH INCLUDING ADDRESSING GRAFFITI AND ITS REMOVAL, PROVIDE VIOLATION AND PENALTY PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SAME, AND TO AMEND CHAPTER 430. ZONING. AT SECTION 430-75 IN ORDER TO REMOVE NOISE STANDARDS FROM THE ZONING ORDINANCE DUE TO NOISE NOW BEING ADDRESSED IN NEW CHAPTER 281 AND SEVERABILITY, REPEALER, GENERAL CODE AND EFFECTIVE DATE PROVISIONS.**
